

# FAMILY *Worship Guide*

September 6, 2010

## READ

*Family worship:* Exodus 31:12-18

*Private worship:* Genesis 25-43 (*Spread your reading throughout the week.*)

*Discussion questions:* What do these passages say about God? What do these passages say about me? What do these passages say about the relationship between God and me?

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## PRAY

*Adoration:* God is holy, mighty, gracious, and merciful. Spend time declaring your love for Him.

*Confession:* Continually confessing your sins to God and asking for His forgiveness will keep you from taking the great price Christ paid on the cross for granted.

*Thanksgiving:* Express your thankfulness to God for the blessings He has given you. When we consider that we deserve punishment because of our sinfulness, and instead God gives to us His love and mercy, our only response should be one of thankfulness.

*Supplication:* Pray for the senior adults in your church. Pray that will be spiritual leaders to those who come behind them.

Ask God to show you how to respond to the needs of others.

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## MEMORIZE

**Be sure to review scripture memory verses and catechism questions from previous weeks!**

**Scripture:** “Sitting down, Jesus called the Twelve and said, ‘If anyone wants to be first, he must be very last, and the servant of all.’” –Mark 9:35 (NIV)

**Catechism:**

100. Q. Who can change a sinner’s heart?

A. Only the Holy Spirit can change a sinner's heart. (Jn. 3:3; Rm. 8:6-11; 1 Cor. 2:9-14; 2 Thes. 2:13, 14; Titus 3:5-6).

101. Q. What did the Holy Spirit undertake in the covenant of Grace?

A. He regenerates, baptizes, and seals those for whom Christ has died (Ep. 2:1-8; 1 Cor. 12:13; Ep. 1:13, 14; Ep. 4:30; 2 Cor. 1:22).
